John W. Wagner paints landscapes and portraits in oil and pastel. He has taught classes in Gloucester, Mass., where he maintained a summer studio/gallery in the Rocky Neck Art Colony. He also taught classes for about 10 years in a studio on Strathallan Park in Rochester, N.Y. And, he taught and demonstrated in Maine.

John studied at the Art Students League, Rochester Institute of Technology, Art Career School

in New York City, and in private lessons with Carl Peters, Jack Callahan, John Howard Sanden and Everett Raymond Kinstler.

John is a member of the Salmagundi Club in New York City and the Rochester Art Club, and he is a former president, Penfield Art Association. John displayed paintings in the Salmagundi Spring and Fall Shows, 2002-2008. He was awarded Salmagundi's John Lafarge Award for the painting "Pemaquid Harbor," the N.C. Wyeth Award for "Portland Harbor"; the Rochester Art Club's Award of Excellence for "Fall Woods" and the RAC's Staudermeier Award for "Africa's Tomorrow,"

He is represented by the Bryan Memorial Gallery in Jeffersonville, Vt. John's painting of Col. Patrick O'Rorke leading the 140th New York State Regiment at the Battle of Little Round during the Civil War is exhibited at St. John Fisher College. His paintings also are included in numerous private collections.

ARTIST SPOTLIGHT— Kitty Lawrence



I was fortunate to be born into a family of artists, mostly from my maternal side. My mother, uncle, aunt, great aunt, and grandfather are or were active painters or art educators, primarily using watercolors and oils. Growing up amid this family influence was inspiring—comments on color, shapes, reflections, shadows, vistas, etc.—whether on a hike—or at the dinner table—helped develop my ability to observe and appreciate.

As a graduate of RIT's Art and Design program in the 70s I entered the career world as a designer on a weekly rural



newspaper, as a structural designer of folding cartons, as a manager of an art dept. in a large printing



company, as an art director in an advertising company, and finally/currently, as an independent graphic design professional—all eventually resulting in 50+ local, national, and international awards for design.

I started painting again in the mid-90s choosing watercolors, influenced by those family members mentioned previously. To-date nature, landscapes, still life, and more recently scenes with people in them have been my focus. When contemplating creation of a new





piece of art I try to challenge myself to choose different subjects or different perimeters such as high-key, vignette, or palette selection, etc. My future may hold exploration into oils and pastels.

Art classes and instruction with Fred Lipp, g. a. Sheller, Joanne Lindsey, Valerie Larson, and Dick Kane have helped me develop skills and explore different techniques.

As a second year PAG member I am currently acting as Treasurer. Being involved is helping me learn about the club and its opportunities, and it is providing an important connection to fellow artists.


