We have guidelines spelled out, and of course, the Board will be there to help out!




### Recap of September's Meeting

#### From the Archives....

Particularly for newcomers, I am revising and adding to some of the articles written for the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2011. I also am creating a list of materials that are missing from the archives that will be published periodically.

On January 26, 1961, an article appeared in the Brighton Pittsford Post announcing that a meeting was scheduled for Thursday, February 2 to form a new Pittsford art group. It was to be held at 8 pm in the Pittsford Town Hall and was open to all residents of Pittsford and adjoining towns who were interested in painting and sketching. Mrs. William Reinhard of 234 Tobey Road, the temporary chairman, set an agenda to schedule meetings, elect officers and organize programs (TU 1/31/61)

About 50 people attended that first meeting and Mrs. Reinhard explained that the intent was to "provide opportunities for painting and sketching for the people of Pittsford through paint workshops and study sessions with prominent area artists." Two members of the Irondequoit Art Club were guests and artists, Bruce Benton, Maurice Potter and C.P. McCartney attended. McCartney showed some of his watercolor paintings (TU 2/9/61). The official name became Pittsford Art Group and Mrs. (Tori) Reinhard was elected the first president.

The first painting sessions were scheduled for a week later and a still life was to be available. The sessions would be held in the Pittsford Town Hall, one at 12:30 and a second at 7:30. Subsequent meetings were held every Thursday from 9:30-4 and the 1st, 2nd and 4th Thursdays from 7:30-10:30. Club members had to be over 18 and the dues were \$5 for one member or \$8 for a couple. Paid members could exhibit in shows and receive discounts on artist supplies. By March the Group already had 40 members. (BPP 3/16/61)

All paid up members, who had attended at least 4 functions a year, were eligible to enter pictures in shows. Honors were awarded in three categories—beginner, experienced and advanced. A beginner had two or less years of art instruction and experience or who "had never held a brush except to paint the kitchen walls". Experienced painters were those who could produce a "good picture" with little advice. Advanced were professionals and those who either had many and varied years of courses and/or who had been painting for many years. (BPP 3/16/61)
