# February 2022 Guest Artist - Princewill Robinson

Will is originally from Nigeria, went to school in Canada, has been in Rochester for approximately 3 years and is a handyman/contractor. In Kentucky he drew portraits of elderly in a homeless shelter.

Will purchases his canvas from Walmart (can be purchased from the fabric department) and cuts it and stretches it to the size he needs.

He paints in oil and acrylic and paints the background canvas with acrylic and oil on top. He does landscapes and portraits. Will mixed blue, yellow and black paints for the background he demonstrated. Will prefers to use a small brush which allows him to control the shading of the area he is painting. Sometimes he draws pencil lines to guide his painting and other times he just freehands the painting. He uses Winsor & Newton oil paints.





For this painting he used brown, yellow, white, and red and uses a soft brush which helps blend the colors as he paints. He uses odorless paint thinner as a medium to help apply the paint on the canvas. Will finds pictures on Pinterest as inspiration for paintings.
