Since then, he has been producing art daily, working mainly in finely detailed and controlled watercolor and pen and ink, but venturing also into abstract pieces with oils and gauche. A graduate of RIT, Dick Roberts worked commercially as an illustrator and artist for clients such as Kodak, Ward's Natural Science, WXXI and




